WPS CAREERS TALKS


We are running Careers Talks throughout the year to give our Year 10 and Sixth Form learners an insight to the world of work.

POST 16 APPRENTICESHIP OPTIONS

We are keen to support all of our learners with their next steps and making them aware of different opportunities that are available to them after their GCSEs.

COLLEGE PROVIDERS

Moulton College offer a variety of different post 16 options including traditional apprenticeships; to find out more please click here.

Northampton College are offering both apprenticeship and T-Level opportunities. T-Levels are available to those who complete their GCSE's; these courses are equivalent to three A Levels.
