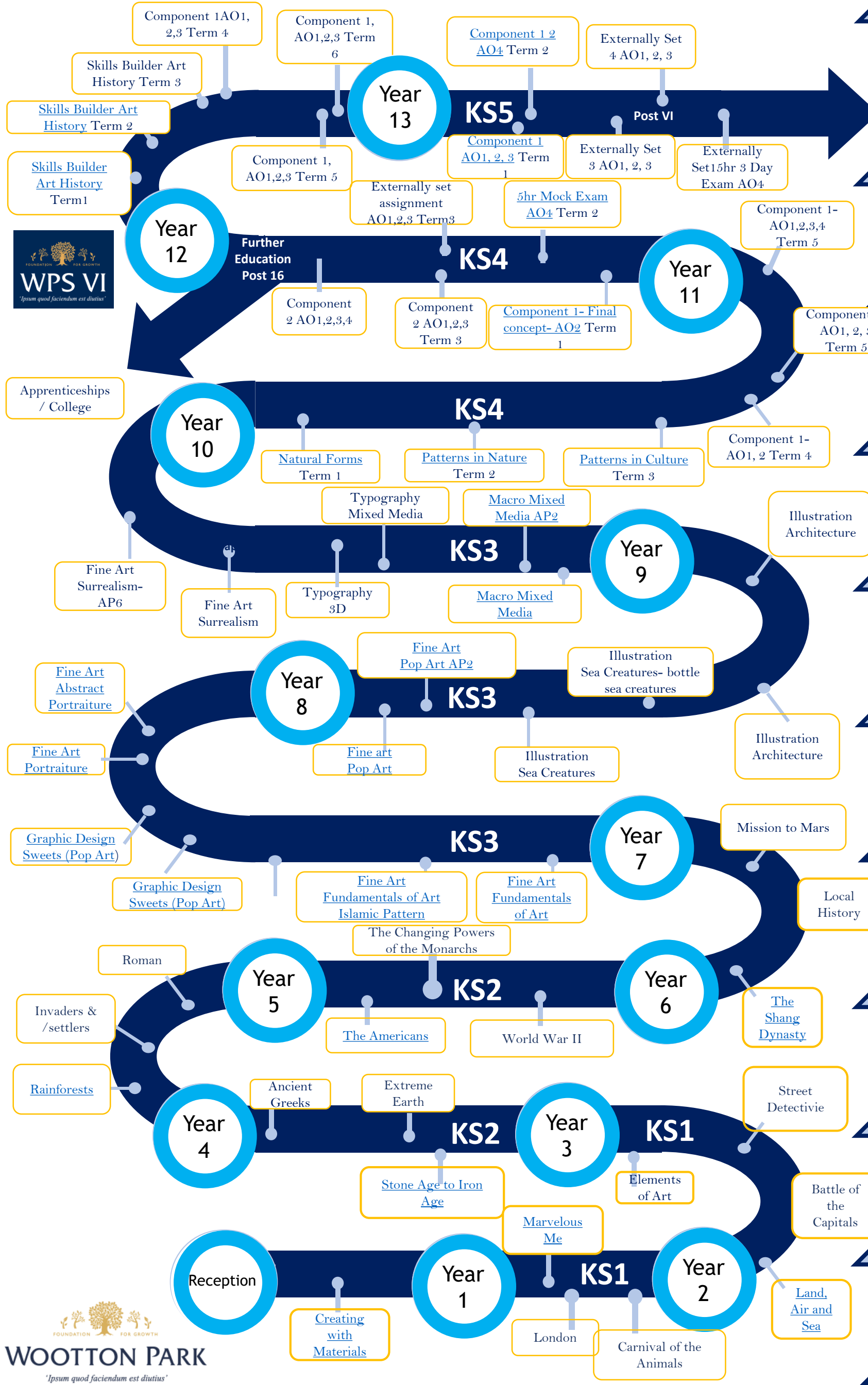


Art Learning Journey
