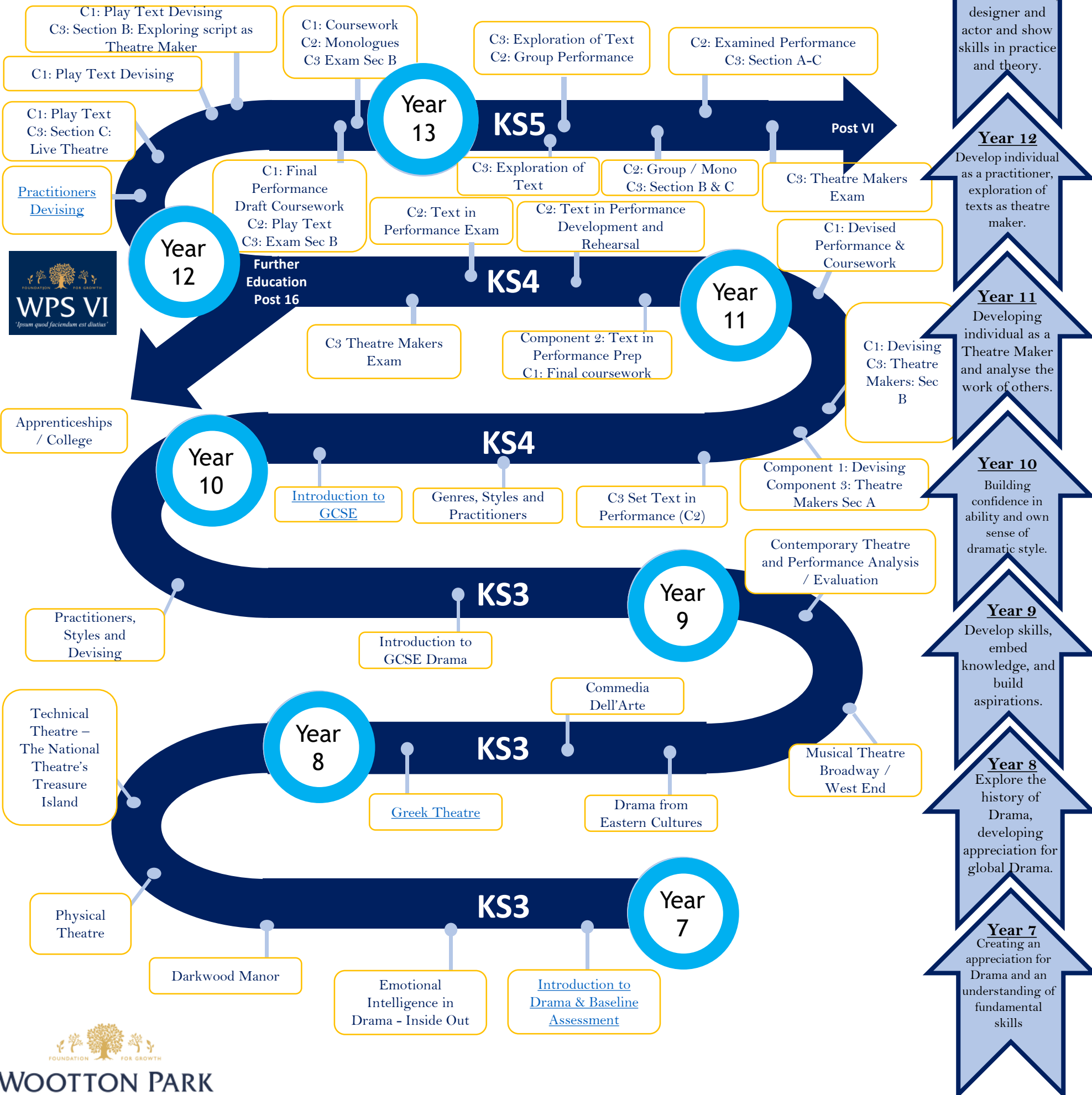


Performing Arts: Drama Learning Journey

Drama within the curriculum at Wootton Park School blends both practical and theoretical aspects of drama to ensure learners within drama are actively involved and engaged in their learning. A learner at WPS will have the opportunity to express their individual creativity within the curriculum as well develop knowledge and skills in order to make them both a drama practitioner in their own right, but also a well rounded, culturally aware individual within society.

Learners will develop their understanding of how to create and develop ideas that communicate meaning. Our learners will demonstrate the knowledge and understanding of how drama is performed and developed both in their own practice and in the observation of professional works. They will also explore different roles within the field of drama, as an actor, director and designer, applying theatrical skills to realise their intentions to live performance. Finally our learners will develop their analytical and evaluative skills both of their own work and the work of professionals within the industry.
