Wootton Park School's Online Learning Approach: EYFS

Overview

There are four different strands to engage with the curriculum:

- **Learning Sessions** (these will replace your lessons and have essential elements you must complete)
- **Activities** (these are optional but will help consolidate the learning from the taught session)
- **Wellbeing Wednesdays** (optional)
- **Enrichment Clubs** (optional)

Through these four strands there should be enough material to keep the most studious and ambitious learner busy.

Learning Sessions

We will be delivering 12 sessions across the week that are distributed across the curriculum. The EYFS team will publish all sessions for the week on the Sunday for the week ahead (this will become effective on Sunday 10th January ready for the week beginning 11th January). This will allow you to complete the sessions on the days that work best for you. We will be using the memo section of Tapestry therefore please check this daily (please see the video with regards to accessing memo's https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KQgO_eaD7k0). We will label each session by the week, subject and order e.g. W.C. 02.02.2021 Monday Phonics.

I taught Tilly the 'le' sound today, we also recapped phase 3 'igh'. Tilly read real and nonsense words, matched picture cards to words and then wrote sound buttons on them. She finished off her work by writing sentences with 'le' words in them.

Read 'Snails', we talked a lot around the content and I asked her a number of comprehension questions. I learnt that a snails body is called the foot!

Maths - we looked at time, she remembered a lot from her lessons with Mrs Webb. Tilly was very confident with o'clock and could tell me the time using 'half past', when I mixed the two up Tilly had to think more carefully about her answers, we consolidated this work using the games on Education City and using her own bedtime clock.

Wellbeing Wednesday

This is a day where we would encourage your child to take a break from their screens and do something different. We will send ideas out to help you keep them active and engaged, but what they do that day is up to you and your child. Your child could:

- catch up with work or complete stretch activities from sessions they have enjoyed;
- complete an enrichment club activity;
- get involved in the 'Weekly Wootton Wellbeing Challenge'; or
- just have the day off!

Enrichment Clubs

These will be a collection of our current and past clubs, set up as either projects to download and complete or online courses. They are completely optional and your child can get involved as much or as little as they like. They will be lots of fun and are predominantly **not academic** in nature. Further details will follow shortly.
