## **Summary of Clubs**

### **Archery Club**

We are really lucky to have qualified archery coaches coming into school from Indoor Archery Ltd which is based in Brackmills, Northampton. During the club, learners will have the opportunity to use adapted, safe and child friendly archery equipment. It will be a great opportunity for learners to try a new sport that we haven't previously offered.

### **Recorder Club**

A club where they learn to play the recorder and build on their musical knowledge through learning fun and enjoyable melodies. Recorders are provided.

### **Science Club**

Learners will take part in a range of experiments and they will be given the opportunity to further develop their enquiry skills and confidence with activities.

### **Newspaper Club**

EXTRA, EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT!' Learners will become reporters and work as a team to produce a termly newspaper aimed at WPS Primary learners. Together we will learn how to research, write and edit interesting articles whilst sticking to deadlines. If you are creative and enjoy storytelling then this is the perfect club for you!

### **Film Club**

Come and join film club where we enjoy getting cosy and watching a range of movies. What's a film without snacks? Bring some tasty snacks along and relax!

### **ICT Club**

In ICT club the learners go onto Purple Mash which is an online tool, where they can play games or focused activities such as number counting, colouring and drawing which are educational based to encourage creative learning. Some learners also go on to Time Table Rock Star to further strengthen their existing time table skills.

### **iPad Club**

To access the internet or use apps to play fun phonics and maths games. The learners also use Times Tables Rock Star.

### **Craft Club**

Creating different crafts using a range of materials, using their imagination and creativity skills.

### **Relax Kids**

Relax kids helps emotional health and wellbeing. We play mindful games and learn relaxation techniques. We hope to build positivity, resilience, compassion, and gratitude.

### **Just Dance**

Learners will enjoy learning and performing dance routines through the medium of online dance. Learners will follow an avatar and dance to range of modern music that they enjoy.

### **Mindfulness Club**

Mindfulness club is a calm club. We do activities such as yoga, mindfulness colouring as well as make things such as stress balls and glitter jars.

### **Spanish Club**

Primary Spanish Club gives the learners opportunities to learn Spanish but something slightly different to the usual lessons. This term we are looking at the story book 'The hungry caterpillar'. We will learn different animals, read through the story and then create our own animal stories. Please only sign up once to this Spanish club as it'll be repeated.

### **Young Voices**

The learners will sing contemporary and classic songs and medleys all the way from jazz classics to chart toppers and everything in between. We are currently practising a Moana Mashup which, when learnt, will incorporate dance as well. The aim of the club is for us to join the nationwide Young Voices choir and perform next January at the Young Voices concert in Birmingham along with thousands of other children.

### **Dodgeball**

A sports club designed to develop all skills needed during a dodgeball game (accurate throwing/dodging/teamwork).

### **No-Bake Cooking Club**

It is a cooking club that requires no oven and will be baking something each week to bring home! A voluntary donation of £2 will cover the clubs cooking resources.

### **Hockey Club**

This is an external club run by Northampton Hockey Club. It is open to learners in year 2/3 and will introduce them to the sport of Hockey. The club will teach a variety of skills such as dribbling, passing and shooting. Hockey is a great sport for developing teamwork and hand-eye coordination. There will be opportunities later in the year for learners that have attended this club to go to a competition on a Monday evening at Moulton College.

### **Style Stars Dance Club**

StyleStars offer professionally trained teaching, where the children learn a variety of dance skills and technique. At the end of the term, parents/carers will be invited to watch a performance of the work the children have been learning in the session.

### **Animation Club**

Animation club is a creative club where we will plan and create our own stories to tell through flipbooks and stop motion video.
