

Admissions 2019-2020: Randomisation

To ensure that the randomisation process is conducted in a secure, transparent, and ethical manner, Wootton Park School undertakes this process in the presence of an independent person who has no connection to the school.

Using an outside independent witness to verify the whole randomisation process ensures that Wootton Park School has acted in accordance with Section 1.35 of the Admissions Code 2014.

The independent person is asked to:

- Confirm the data request serial number.
- Randomise the list (by following the randomisation process).
- Verify that the list of records has been randomised.
- Sign and date the printed report to ensure that the list can be identified as the original, and that no further changes can be made to the document.
