EYFS Christmas Craft Day


Last Wednesday we invited parents and grandparents to our Christmas Craft day.

We have this amazing opportunity for all our learners to download Microsoft office to their home devices. Installing your free copy of Microsoft Office 365 ProPlus 2016

It is highly recommended that the download for this installation be carried out where the device that will host the application is connected to the WiFi, so that mobile devices do not run the risk of using up all data allowance (where applicable).



This guide will take you through the installation of Microsoft Office ProPlus 2016 step-by-step.

1) From the device you want to install Office, sign into your O365 account using the credentials you use at school to access your emails: https://login.microsoftonline.com/login




2) In the welcome page, click on the button "Install Office 2016", or alternatively click on "Other installations" for Office 2013 and other applications:
