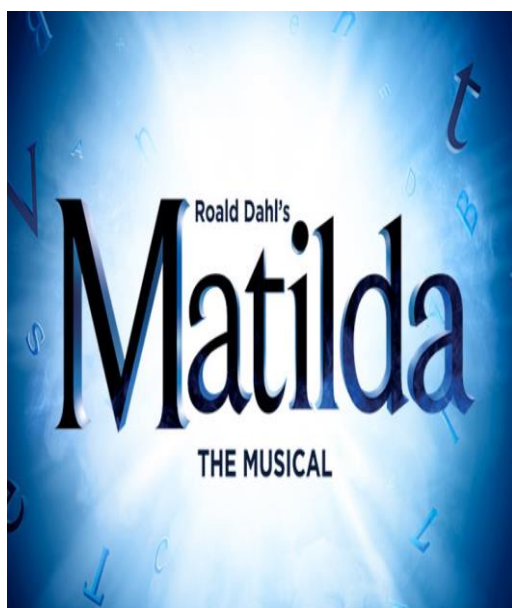
Site Update
